

Status and Accomplishment in PI Activities in the Philippines
January to September 2002

- Public information in the Philippines is a series of activities and projects implemented by the Nuclear Information and Training Section of the Nuclear services and Training Division, Philippine Nuclear Research Institute.
- The program is focused on the younger generation, we believe to be the major players in future nuclear energy applications specially nuclear power.

As of September 2002, 1,500 students and faculty from 41 schools were entertained. 121 walk-in visitors from 37 schools were also given assistance.

Seminars were organized with invited speakers or specialist from the institute returning from fellowship abroad

General information seminars were organized at 9 public and private schools with about 1,430 attendees

Summer on-the-job training for students or thesis advisor-ship opportunities were organized with 109 students availing of the activity.

Information materials or lecture materials were distributed to visitors and participants of our training courses respectively. About 34,000 printed materials were given to 9,580 guests and participants.
