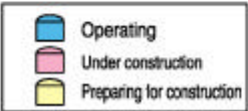
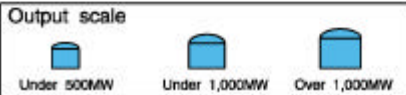
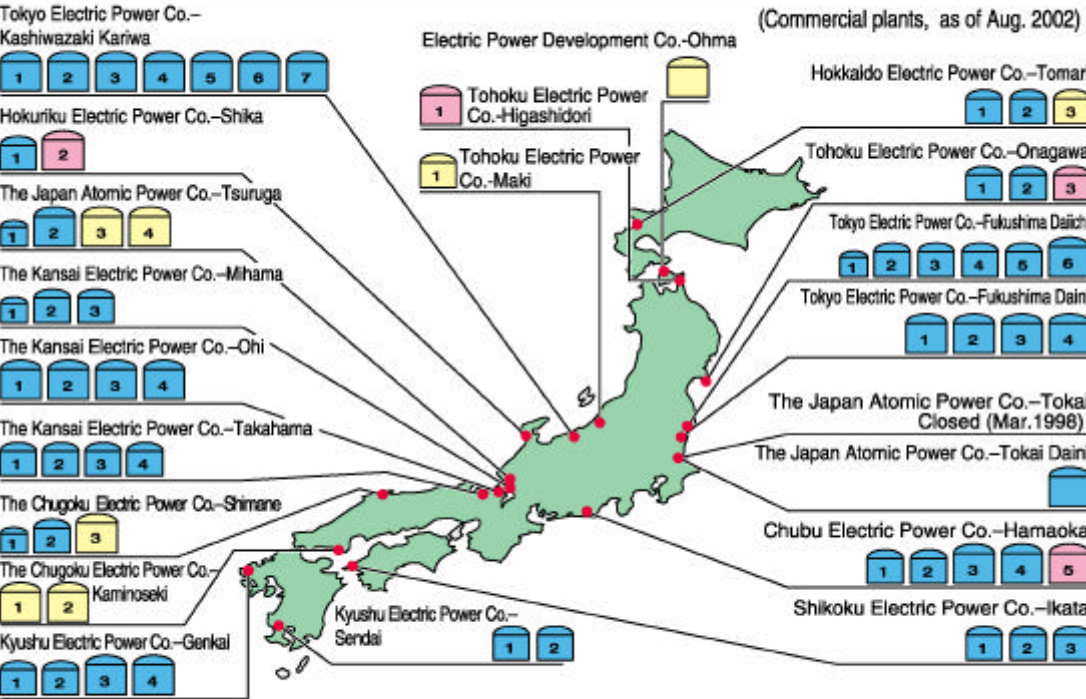

- *Reflect the raw opinion of residents on information disclosure policy*
- *Create a sense of unity and security with local communities, facing questions or requests to power stations.*

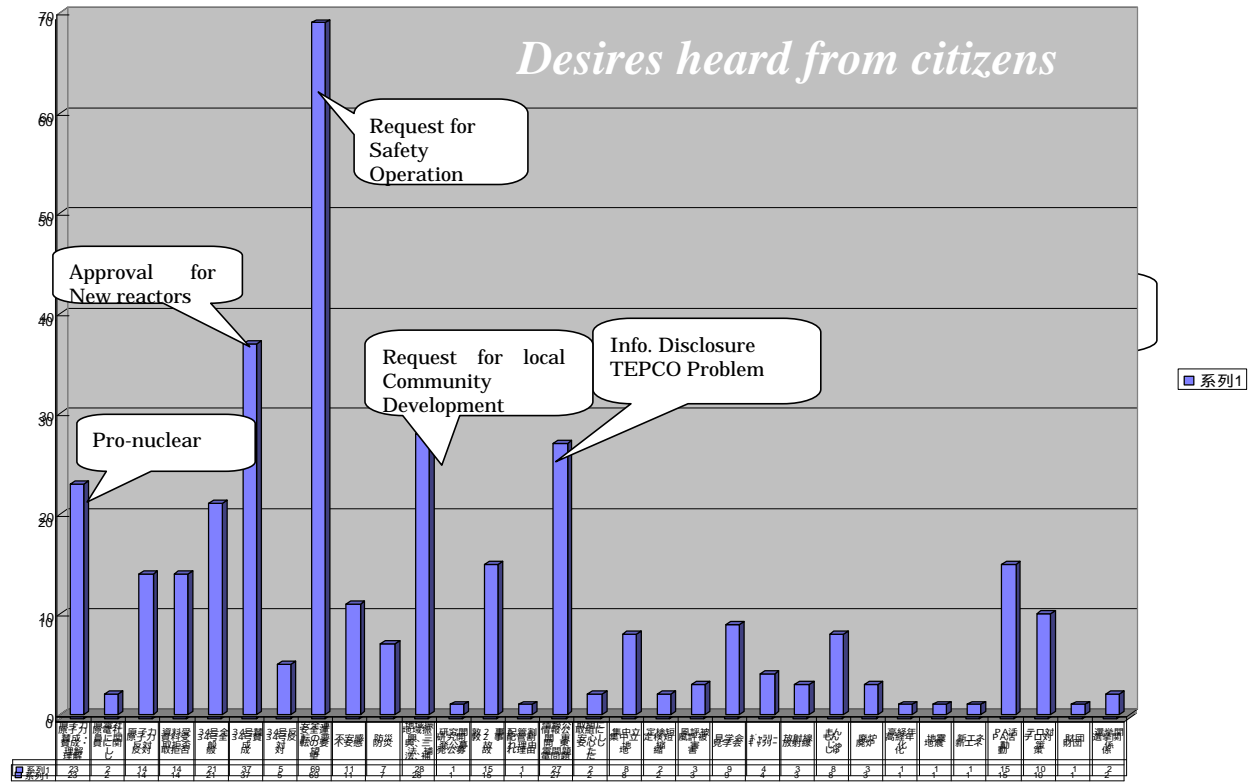
*The case of the Tsuruga Area

*Door to door visit to all homes
in local communities*

- *Tsuruga area: 2 units (360MWe BWR and 1,160MWe PWR at Tsuruga Nuclear Power Station*
- *No. of homes: 24,109 (all) of 69,000 populated Tsuruga City*
- *Period: Nov. 28, 2002 - Feb. 7, 2003*
- *Man-visits: Total 730 by 2 members per home visit team.*
- *Themes at visits:
radioactivity, radiation, TEPCO problem and JAPC's counter-measures, energy situation, nuclear systems and safety, construction of Tsuruga 3 and 4 units, protection against disasters, etc.*

Guest Teacher at schools

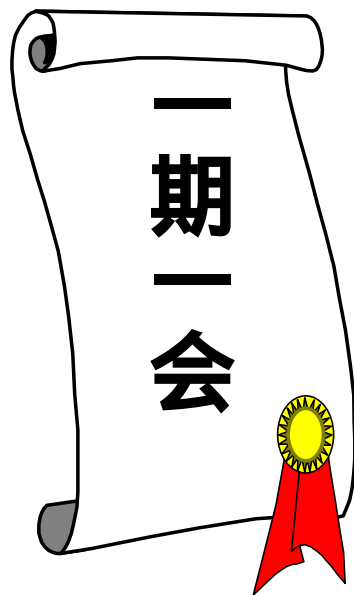
Guest Teachers dispatched at Primary & Junior High Schools
