Verbal Communication(1)

- Prepare an answer even if you face an easy question.
- Be easy to understand, and explain.
- Prepare for the expression which is always concise.
- You must not answer the question under the supposition based on a guess.
- It must not be provoked by the press's question. Keep self-control.
- Avoid a negative expression. The end of the explanation is made to end in affirmative expression.

Verbal Communication (2)

- Explain contribution to the community and to the public people by the nuclear energy.
- It is explained that it is careful of the people.
- Understand and explain the design of the safety of the facilities often.
